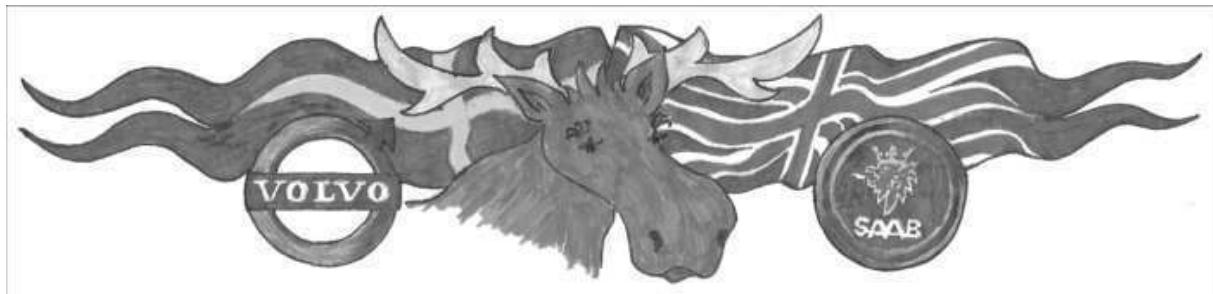

Regulations & Information for all

- 1. Times of opening.** The gates will be open for trade & exhibitors at 7am. If you need special arrangements please contact the show office prior to arrival.
- 2. Passes.** The Vehicle Pass allows the vehicle and its occupants to park in the show area.
- 3. Camping.** Sorry but there is no camping on site. There are local camp sites around the Yeovil area.
- 4. Parking.** Any vehicle not exhibiting will be directed to the public parking area.
- 5. Stands.** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they have booked enough space. The allocation of the stands will be entirely at the discretion of the organisers. Only the approved catering stands are allowed to sell food or drink.
- 6. Description of goods.** An accurate description of goods to be sold must be included on this booking form.
- 7. Judging.** Please be available to allow vehicles to be started and fully examined. Only vehicles that have paid their entrance fee will be judged.
- 8. Site plan.** The organisers reserve the right to alter the site plan at their discretion. Any damage caused to the site will be charged at cost.
- 9. Plaques/Mementos.** These will only be given to exhibitors who have paid the entry fee.
- 10. Insurance.** Exhibitors are required to take out the necessary insurance against fire and all other risks including third party claims. The exhibitor must also indemnify the Event organisers against all claims, damages or expense whatsoever in any way arising out of his attendance or his exhibits on the event site. This completed booking form shall be deemed as confirmation by the Exhibitor that the necessary insurance cover has been obtained. Failure to bring all relevant and valid insurance, safety certificates, licenses and risk assessments to the show for inspection could result in the exhibit, stand or ride being unable to operate.
- 11. Responsibilities.** The exhibitor shall assume full responsibility for all claims arising out of the exhibition, handling or housing of such exhibits or articles for sale. The exhibitor shall indemnify the Promoters, Sponsors and Organisers against all claims, damages or expenses arising out of the presence of the exhibitor or exhibits at the showground.
- 12. Security.** The trade stand holders and exhibitors are responsible for the safe keeping of their goods. The Event organisers will not be responsible in any way for the loss, misuse or damage to the exhibitor's property whilst on the showground. The Security and Event Organisers reserve the right to remove and inform the local authorities of anyone causing nuisance or acting in an illegal or dangerous manor.
- 13. Safety.** Please remember that the Road Traffic Act applies. All vehicles must be insured and only driven by persons holding a valid driving licence for that vehicle. Exhibitor's electrical equipment should carry a current copy of a relevant safety certification and be available for inspection at the event.
- 14. Fire Precautions.** Exhibitors must familiarise themselves with the relevant site fire precautions and evacuation criteria held at the show office. All stands must have in their possession a suitable fire extinguisher and be aware that they may be inspected by the Fire Prevention Officer.
- 15. Electricity.** Where an exhibitor provides their own electricity supply, this should be installed in accordance with the current regulations for temporary electrical supplies.
